

**For Permanent Vote-by-Mail voters who are not registered with a political party.
Do you want to vote for President on June 7, 2016?**

If you are not registered with a political party, you must let the county elections official know if you want to receive a ballot with the office of President.

Because you are requesting a party ballot after the April 8 deadline, you may receive a nonpartisan ballot in the mail before you receive the party ballot.

Three political parties allow you to vote in their Presidential Primary: Democratic, American Independent, and Libertarian. Use this form to select a party and return it to the Santa Cruz County Elections Official ASAP.

To vote in the Presidential Primary for the Republican, Green, or Peace & Freedom parties, you must re-register to vote with that party before May 23, 2016.
