Thank you for applying to be a Santa Cruz County Elections Worker.

Our staff will call you to confirm your assignment and you will also receive confirmation in writing prior to the next election.

Polling place clerks are paid \$75 and inspectors are paid \$100. Poll workers are paid an additional \$20 for attending a required 3-hour training class held prior to Election Day. You must work at a polling place to receive the \$20.
