I have served as the Mayor of Watsonville and Councilmember prior to representing the 4th District on the Board of Supervisors since 1998. - Served as Chair for the Board of Supervisors, Pajaro River Management Plan Advisory Committee, Zone 7/ Pajaro Valley Storm Drain District and participated on many commissions
