VOTE EARLY 29 days before the election, the Santa Cruz County Elections Department and Watsonville City Clerk's Office open as polling places.

Voters may pick up a ballot or vote there.

☞ Santa Cruz – 701 Ocean St., Room 210, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday thru Friday. Phone: 831-454-2060

☞ Watsonville – 215 Union St., 2nd Floor, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday thru Friday. Phone: 831-728-6005

VOTE BY MAIL Voters may request a ballot to be mailed to them for this one election or for all future elections.

Submit written application (see back cover or online at www.votescount.com) by mail, FAX or in person by 5 p.m. at least 7 days before Election Day.

The first day to mail ballots is 29 days before the election. Overseas and military personnel and dependents may obtain a ballot 60 days before the election – ask your commanding officer or go to www.votescount.com

WEEKEND VOTING Vote on the weekend prior to the Election on October 30 & 31 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. at the following locations:

☞ Santa Cruz – 701 Ocean St., Room 210, Phone: 831-454-2060

☞ Watsonville – 250 Main St., Phone: 831-728-6005

This is considered late absentee voting and is available to persons who are ill, disabled, or will be absent from their precinct on Election Day.

Absentee voters who still have their ballots are encouraged to drop them off.

VOTE AT YOUR POLLING PLACE

Polls open at 7 a.m. and close at 8 p.m.

YOUR POLLING PLACE LOCATION MAY HAVE CHANGED from where you voted in the last election. Please refer to the back label to determine where you are assigned to vote.

If you are assigned to a mail ballot precinct, there are 250 or fewer voters in your area, so you will automatically be mailed a ballot.
