Be a Poll Worker!

What is a poll worker?

- Poll workers check in voters, set up and manage the polls
- Poll workers are needed on **Tuesday, November 8**
- People who speak Spanish, Tagalog, or Chinese are especially needed

Who can apply?

- A registered voter in the state of California
- A student at least 16 years of age in good standing with a GPA of 2.5 or better and a citizen of the US or legal permanent resident who has permission from a parent and a teacher
- A legal permanent resident of the US

What are the hours?

- Most poll workers work from 6am - 11pm.
- You may sign up with a friend to split the day.
- Polls are open from 7am - 8pm Election Day

Jobs Available and Pay

- Inspectors = \$100
- Electronic Voting Specialist = \$75
- Clerks=\$75
- You also get paid for going to training!

You must work at the polls to receive payment for attending training.
