

## November 8, 2022 Statewide General Election

### Important dates for jurisdictions calling elections

(as of 2/19/2021 – subject to change)

<b>May/June 2022</b>	<p>Suggested time for jurisdictions holding elections in November to pass a resolution that 1) orders the election; 2) requests the Santa Cruz County Elections Department to conduct the election, and 3) consolidates it with any other jurisdiction holding an election on that same day.</p> <p>The following documents can be found on our website at <a href="http://www.votescount.com">www.votescount.com</a></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Sample Resolution for School Districts</li><li>• Sample Resolution for Cities/Special District</li></ul>
<b>August 12, 2022</b>	<p>Last day to call an election or file for office. If the incumbent does not file, filing is extended for 5 calendar days for anyone other than the incumbent.</p>
<b>August 12, 2022</b>	<p>Deadline for filing tax rate statement for bond measures. Last day to file Tax Rate Statement for any bond measure appearing on the November ballot.</p>
<b>August 19, 2022</b>	<p>Deadline for filing arguments for or against local ballot measures.</p> <p>Deadline for filing analyses of local ballot measures.</p>
<b>August 26, 2022</b>	<p>Deadline for filing rebuttals.</p>
<b>September 9, 2022</b>	<p>First day to mail ballots to military and overseas voters</p>
<b>October 10, 2022</b>	<p>First day to mail ballots to vote-by-mail voters.</p>
<b>October 24, 2022</b>	<p>Last day to register to vote in November 2022 election.</p>
<b>November 5 &amp; 6, 2022</b>	<p>Weekend voting – open 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. at Santa Cruz County Elections and Watsonville City Hall.</p>
<b>November 8, 2022</b>	<p>Election Day – polls open at 7 a.m. and close at 8 p.m.</p>
<b>November 11, 2022</b>	<p>E+3 – VBM ballots postmarked on or before Election Day and received by June 10 will be counted.</p>
<b>December 4, 2022</b>	<p>E+26 – last day to cure an unsigned signature on VBM envelope.</p>
